Lambton County has relatively flat topography and was influenced by glacial landscape features such as moraines, and modern geomorphological processes such as stream morphology and erosion. The topography ranges from 175 metres to 270 metres above mean sea level. This map depicts the presence of topographically high moraines in eastern Lambton County and also shows low lying areas in southwestern Lambton County.
