

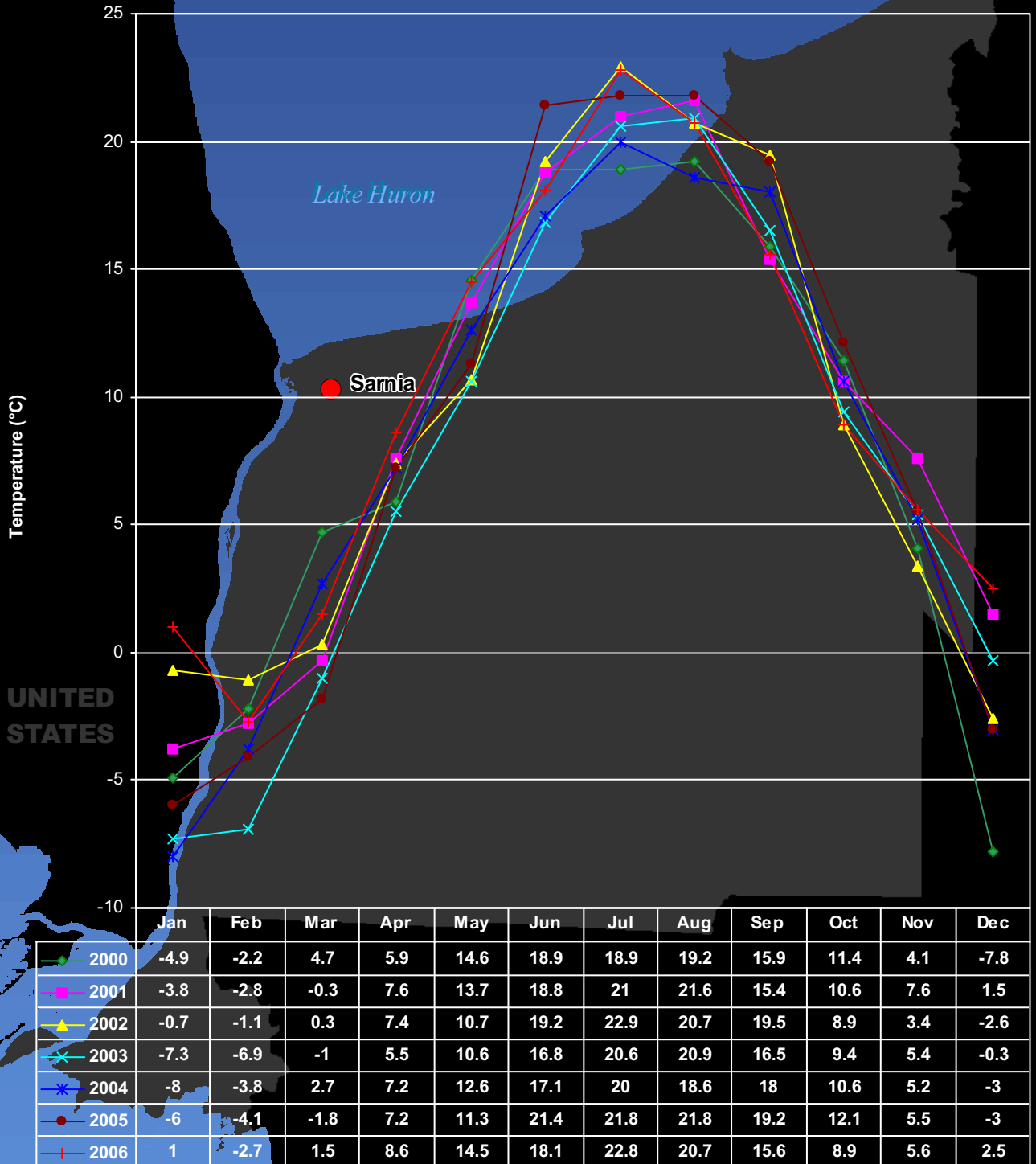
Atlas of LAMBTON COUNTY

2000-2006 Mean Temperature (°C) at City of Sarnia



Sarnia is the largest city in Lambton County and it enjoys one of the warmest climates in Canada. The climate is moderated year-round due to the lake influence. Winters are mild to cold and summers are warm to hot. Unlike the rest of Canada, winters in Sarnia are short with minimal snowfall. Spring comes early and summer's warm temperatures remain long into the autumn.

The graph below illustrates monthly mean temperature over seven years from 2000 to 2006 in Sarnia, which is highlighted on the underlying map. The figures illustrated in the linework representing the variation between the years within the same month are also tabled below the graph.
